Sub : Police Estt. - State wide Seniority list of Reserve Sub Inspectors for the years from 01.01.2003 to 01.01.2010 - Provisional seniority list publishing of - Orders issued.

The state wide combined seniority list of Reserve Sub Inspectors as on 01.01.2002 was finalised and published as per the Police Headquarters proceedings read as 1st paper above.

Further a finalised State-wide Seniority List of RSIs as on 01/04/2010 was published vide Police Headquarters order read as 2nd paper above. But this seniority list was challenged in the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal by Sri.D.Ashok kumar, RSI and others claiming that the assignment of seniority did not meet the 50% quota for direct and promotes. The Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal disposed of the same vide order O.A.2411/2013 dated 21.11.2013 directing the 1st respondent (the State of Kerala) to consider and pass orders on the representations of the petitioners within four months. Subsequently the finalized seniority list of RSIs was cancelled as per Police Headquarters order No.L5/124472/13 dated 11/02/14 in view of the above KAT order dated 21.11.2013.


As per the G.O. (MS) No.171/74/Home dated 18.11.1974, 50% posts of Reserve Sub Inspectors in the District Armed Reserves will be filled up by direct recruitment. The promotee RSIs are being regularised against the 50% vacancies arising in the respective Ranges. As the regularization has been done in 'vacancies' instead of 'posts', there was disparity in the fixation of seniority of RSIs as on 01.01.2002. Hence, as per Police Headquarters order No.L5/8416/08 dated 29.08.2010 it was directed to adopt the criteria in 'posts' to the quota for promotion and direct recruitment of RSIs at the ratio of 1:1 from 01.01.2002 onwards. The seniority list as on 1/01/2002 issued as per order No.L5/102608/2002 dated 31.05.2006 is considered as a settled one, as it was subject to the decisions of Hon'ble Courts.



Hence, all Range IGP were directed to revise the regularization made on or after 01.01.2002 by reserving vacancies equal to the number of persons regularized in excess as on 01.01.2002 and to revise the seniority lists from the year 2002 accordingly. As such all the Ranges have published the revised finalized year wise Seniority list of RSIs vide orders read as 5th to 8th paper above.

In the circumstances, the State wide provisional seniority list of RSIs for the years from 01.01.2003 to 01.01.2010 is published herewith based on the Range wise seniority lists read as 5th to 8th paper above as annexure 1 to 8 appended to this order.

All Unit heads are requested to circulate the provisional seniority list to all concerned within 5 days without fail. All DPCs in districts and Cities are requested to furnish a certificate stating that this seniority list has been circulated to all incumbents. Objection, omission and mistakes, if any, will be reported within 15 days from the date of publishing the list. The Unit heads concerned should forward the representations of the incumbents, if any, to Police Headquarters through the Ranges concerned with specific remarks along with the documents to substantiate the representation of the applicant. If no objection is received within the prescribed time limit, it will be presumed that there is no objection against the seniority list and the provisional seniority list of RSIs will be finalised. Objections received after the expiry of the time limit shall not be entertained at any rate.
