- Sub : AP Bn Estt – Temporary promotion of ASIs/Havildars to the cadre of APSIs/APASIs for filling up the temporary training post as instructional staff by invoking Rule 31 of KS & SSR – revised Orders issued.

Armed Police Battalions in the State consists of 9 Battalions and their strength is barely sufficient to meet the Battalion functions including law and order deployment. Out of the above 9 Battalions, 7 Battalions act as the feeder units to 19 Police Districts. Battalions are acting as sub centers of Kerala Police Academy and providing 9 months recruit training to recruit Police Constables, Driver Police Constables and other Technical categories of Police Constables.

Training is an additional function of Battalions and no separate strength is sanctioned for the purpose. The matter has been brought to the notice of Government through the State Police Chief and 673 posts of Instructional staff and CFs have been created vide reference cited 3rd. The 673 posts of Instructional staff includes 11 Asst Commandants, 23 APIs , 67 APSIs, 22 APASIs, 325 Havildars and 225 CFs.

However due to various court orders, promotions in Battalions are stagnated for the last two decades. At present 922 Recruit Police Constables are undergoing training in various Battalions and will expect to pass out in December 2015. In addition to this another batch of 183 Recruit Police Constables are also under going training and their training will be completed by 2016 May

Advices have been received for around 1500 Police Personnel and their training has to be commenced during September 2015. Again 1461vacancies have been reported to PSC and their training has to be commenced after October 2015.

This is a herculean task and we need the full contingent of officers. But the stagnation in promotion due to litigation has created an exigency and this is a fit case for invoking Rule 31 of KS&SSR 1958 for temporary promotion. As per Govt Circular 19305/Rules – 1/96/P&ARD dated 09.09.1997 Govt sanction is required for temporary promotion. However considering the exigency the promotion to the cadre of APSI/APASI are ordered by invoking rule 31 of KS & SSR and in anticipation of Govt sanction.

At present 40 posts of APSIs in temporary Instructional staff are vacant in Battalions. The promotions are ordered from the list drawn out solely based on the service seniority and approved by all Commandants vide reference cited 1st.

2) The promotions will be subject to revision on further implementing the Judgment of Hon. High Court of Kerala in WP(C) 16441/2011 filed by Sri. Benni E.F, AC, KAP I Bn and any other court proceedings in future.

3) The Promotee will be reverted /demoted without notice for want of vacancy in Battalions due to the repatriations of direct/regular APSIs/APASIs from deputation/special unit, if any.
