Dear Sir,

I am writing to thank you for the assistance of Sub Inspector K P Viktamrd and his officers.

On the 24th of December I was on holiday with family in Marari Beach Kerala. My 15 year old daughter was assaulted on the beach by local boys, the perpetrators were chased and detained by local homestay owners and taken to the local police station.

Sub Inspector Vikramrd immediately started an investigation and identified one of the assailants. He treated my daughter with kindness, compassion and dignity reminding her that she was the victim and that by identifying the boy she would prevent further offences in the future.

After taking her statement he ensured that we were taken back to our homestay and the owner was informed of what had happened.

Having visited India on a number of occasions including in an official capacity as a police officer this is the first time I or my family have been the victim of crime and I am led to believe that this is unusual for this area.

Throughout this investigation he and his officers acted with the utmost professionalism and integrity. I would like to bring this officers actions to your attention and would be grateful if you could pass on a copy of this letter to the officer.
