In the light of the Government direction vide paper read as 1st above, the seniority list of Assistant Police Sub Inspectors of Police in the Armed Police Battalion has been revised with effect from 18/01/1984 to 31/12/1997 and published vide Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above. The regularization process of the personnel appointed in the Police Department under Sports Quota was carried out as per the Special Rules and as per the suggestions of the High Level Committee constituted for the purpose of regularization of the sports personnel. But, so many Original Applications were filed before the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal against the said seniority list and the Hon'ble Tribunal had quashed the same vide Order read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above.


02.            The important point that considered by the Hon'ble Tribunal for the disposal of the Original Applications was " the date with effect from which a person appointed to supernumerary posts will get seniority;

whether it is from the date of appointment or from the date the incumbent is subsequently accommodated in a regular vacancy. The Original applications were finally disposed by the Hon. Kerala Administrative Tribunal arriving at a conclusion that such appointees are entitled to get seniority with effect from the date they were appointed in the supernumerary posts. The same point was also delivered by the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal in another Order dated 17/09/2014 while disposing the Transferred Applications 6407/2012 and 3994/2012 filed by Sri.P.V.Raju and others. As such, the entire regularization that had been made before needs to be revised and hence the Department has compelled to revise the Seniority lists from the category of Havildar onwards in view of the observations of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal.

03. Accordingly, a revised finalized seniority list of Havildars has been published by the Additional Director General of Police, Armed Police Battalion vide reference read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above and a Select list of Havildars fit for promotion as Armed Police Assistant Sub Inspector has been prepared and published vide 5<sup>th</sup> paper above. Consequent to this a revised provisional seniority list of Armed Police Assistant Sub Inspectors for the period from 18/01/1984 to 31/12/1997 is hereby prepared and published for circulation among all concerned. The list is also published in the Official Web site of Kerala Police for publicity.

04. The unit heads ( Commandants / DIG AP BN ) concerned should circulate the list among all concerned properly. Corrections / omissions / Complaints /Objections if any against the provisional seniority list, should be forwarded to the undersigned within 15 days from the date of its publication through proper channel. ADGP AP BN / DIG AP BN should forward such objections to PHQ within the time limit along with their specific remarks together with the documents to substantiate the claim. Belated Objections / Complaints will not be entertained at any circumstances. The Unit Heads will ensure that sufficient copies of this seniority lists are taken and circulated among the concerned without any delay.

05. The provisional seniority list published herewith will be subject to the result of the appeal petition in OP(KAT) No 400/2014 which is filed by Sri.Shanmugaraj and others before the Hon'ble High Court against the Order of Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal in O.A 1752/2012 and connected cases.
